Britannia Walk Hostel

Welcome to Britannia Walk Hostel which is a facility provided by Moorfields Eye Hospital NHS Foundation Trust. Your suitability for hostel is decided by the pre-operative assessment nurse against current criteria as decided by the Trust.

Britannia Walk Hostel is not based on site but approximately 5 minutes walk from the hospital. To be eligible to stay in Britannia Walk you need to be self caring as there is no nursing staff or warden based in the hostel. There is no smoking allowed inside the accommodation.

Once it has been agreed that you are suitable to stay in the hostel you will be given a contract to sign.

- This states that you will not remain in the room any longer than agreed.
- The accommodation is for single use only. Visitors are not permitted in the hostel and this is reflected in the agreement.

It is advisable that you report to the hospital's main entrance between 7pm & 9pm.

A single room will be provided and you may have to share a bathroom. It is advisable that you bring food with you as there are no cooking facilities although you can make yourself tea & coffee.

In case of emergencies pick-up the telephone in the hallway which is linked to Moorfields Eye Hospital main switchboard and inform the operator of your requirements.

On arrival, please ensure that you read the fire instructions which you will find on the door of your room.
