Onsite activities

Since our last newsletter in April, we have increased activity on and around the site:

- Completed level 6 terrace decking and planters
- Completed landscaping works to the west of the building
- Started landscaping works to the south and south-east of the building
- Started UKPN works to the west of the building
- Level 11 brown roof installation completed
- Level 9 terraces hard landscape works ongoing
- Level 7 terrace green roof started
- Roof access hatches installation
- Environmental monitoring (noise, dust, vibration)



Upcoming activities

- External works to continue, including BYUK landscaping, Camden landscaping
- Internal architectural and MEP fit-out works to continue across all floors, with progressive inspections
- Completion of roof finishes at levels 6, 7, 8, 9 and 11
- Internal fit-out and plant installation works progressing
- Internal atrium finishes progressing
- Building energisation and MEP commissioning works progressing
- Environmental monitoring (noise, dust, vibration) ongoing



Protecting the environment

Bouygues UK is committed to taking care of and protecting the environment, preventing pollution, and continually improving our environmental performance. Environmental priorities and practices underpin our business objectives and growth.

We will undertake many sustainability initiatives throughout the life of the project. So far, we have:

- implemented environmental monitoring for noise, dust and vibration. We receive hourly reports which enable us to react to any breaches to the agreed limits where works are stopped, and additional measures are implemented.
- introduced a personal protective equipment (PPE) recycling bin as part of our sustainability strategy to reduce waste and prevent improper disposal.
- saved wood waste for the Men's Sheds charity.
- engaged with the community wood recycling scheme.



Charity

Members of the team took part in the Milton Keynes Marathon, raising £3,500 for the Lighthouse Charity, which supports the emotional, physical and financial wellbeing of construction workers and their families.

We also participated in the Dalux Charity Football Match, raising over £1,000 for Barnardo's through a fantastic day of sport and fundraising.

As part of the Lighthouse Charity's Make It Visible campaign, we welcomed the charity to site to raise awareness of mental health and wellbeing support available to our workforce, helping to encourage a culture where seeking support is normalised and accessible.

Hong Kong study tour group visit

We were pleased to welcome over 30 engineering students from Hong Kong as part of the HKCA Young Members Society study tour. Apprentices and work placements

The project has agreed apprenticeship targets with Camden Council under its S106 agreement and we are working closely with the King's Cross Construction Skills Centre to advertise our apprenticeship opportunities.
